To ensure that our high standard of safety is maintained, we ask that all campers are suitably dressed. For riding lessons, long pants and boots with a half inch defined heel are mandatory. Helmets, which we will provide as needed, meet industry standards. All saddles have been equipped with break away stirrups that provide additional safety for the rider. Our senior staff also have Red Cross First Aid Certificates.

What campers will be doing...

All campers will spend 1.5 to 2 hours a day in the saddle. Beginners will have an opportunity to develop an independent and balanced seat and the more advance riders will continue to



develop a training philosophy for their horse on the flat and over fences. Learning the elements of basic care for their own horse such as cleaning, feeding and watering, and recognizing common health issues are all part of the day. Good work habits are developed as all staff and campers join together to keep the barn and working area neat and tidy.
