**SHORT STIRRUP (10:45 a.m.)**

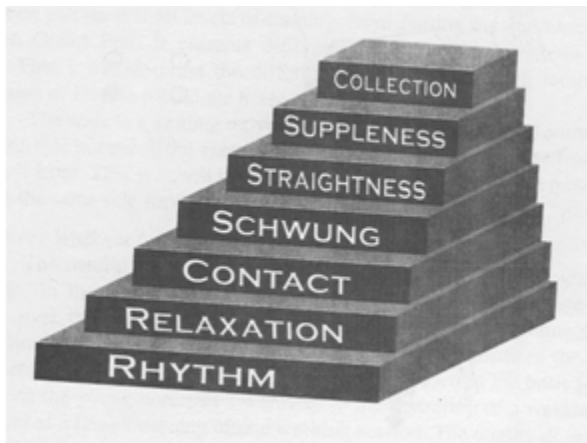
This division is open to students who have begun to work in canter. Horsemanship and riding skills are both tested. A skill-testing question may be required to break a tie.

**HUNTER CROSS RAILS (12:30 p.m.)**

This is open to riders who are just beginning to jump more than a single fence. Riders will be judged on their form as well as their ability to use their corners, determine their lines, and maintain a steady consistent rhythm.

**PRE-OLYMPIANS (2:15 p.m.)**

This division is open to students who have limited horse show experience. Classes will test the students' horsemanship skills on the ground and the ability to control the horse while riding. A skill-testing question may be required to break a tie.

**ADULT DIVISION (over 21!) (9:00 a.m.) with warm up at 8:00 a.m.)**

**HUNTER CROSS RAILS (11:45 a.m. with warm up at 10:45 a.m.)**

This is open to riders who are just beginning to jump more than a single fence. Riders will be judged on their form as well as their ability to use their corners, determine their lines, and maintain a steady consistent rhythm.

**SUNDAY SHORT STIRRUP (1:00 p.m.)**

Open to students who are comfortable working independently in the walk, trot, and canter. A skill-testing question may be required to break a tie.

**OPEN DIVISION (2:30 p.m. with warm up at 1:30 p.m.)**
